

About the Instructors

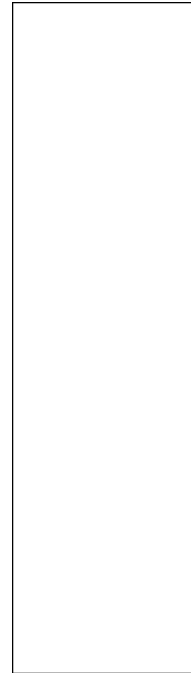
